(1) A participant in the OTSP Competition shall not enforce his claims by legal process.

(2) For participating at the OTSP Competition the participant shall be aged 18 or over and shall have a PayPal account for paying and for getting payments and a Facebook account for posting.

(3) The OTSP Competition ID can be purchased at the online shop <u>www.syngear.co.uk</u>. The OTSP Competition ID is only valid for the next OTSP Competition. For example a OTSP Competition ID ordered on the 5th day of a month after the OTSP Competition on this day is only valid until the OTSP Competition on the 10th day of the same month Manchester time. The same OTSP Competition ID can only win one time.

(4) The OTSP Competition will be running on the 1st, 5th, 10th, 15th, 20th and 25th day of each month from 20:45:00 hours to 21:05:00 hours Manchester time. If a competition is not starting due to technical reasons the OTSP Competition Fee will be returned.

(5) Each participant has the possibility to train the search and reporting process using the facebook messenger under the heading "OTSP Competition" outside the competition time.

(6) Download the pdf-file of the respective page with the password source code for the competition of the book "One Trillion Strong Passwords" with ISBN 978-0-9928602-1-9 provided on page ",http://www.syngear.co.uk/otsp-source-code.php" and print it. The respective page with the password source code for the OTSP Competition will be exchanged from time to time. The upload will take place at least 1 hour before the competition.

(7) Go to the page "http://www.syngear.co.uk/otsp-string-search-competition.php" and refresh the page starting at 20:45 hours Manchester time. Sort the postings by selecting the line "Reverse Chronological".

(8) Push the "Add a comment" button and log into your Facebook account.

(9) There will be the following postings provided:

(10) At 21:00 hours Manchester time copy the last posting provided by Syngear Ltd. and paste it into the comment field. Now amend the participant ID. The participant ID you will get when you have paid your participant fee. It reads for example 10000125. Write it in this way: 1000-0125.

Your comment will now read as follows:

otsp competition 11-07-2014 id = 1000-0125 (1) 12-xx-xx-9< (2) 12-36-15-xx (3) 12-xx-xx-Fr (4) 12-35-05-xx (5) 12-50-20-xx

(11) Now start searching the 5 strings of 2 characters.

(12) It is recommended working in a team of two persons: one person is doing the searching and the other person is doing the writing with the keyboard.

(13) Keep in mind to report the solution in the above mentioned format. So when you find a string of 2 characters starting at column 1 please write "01".

(14) When you have found all 5 single solutions then you can post the solution.

(15) A solution will read as follows

otsp competition 11-07-2014 id = 1000-0125 (1) 12-01-80-9< (2) 12-36-15-s] (3) 12-02-03-Fr (4) 12-35-05-@8 (5) 12-50-20-OG

Number (5) reads as follows: page 12 - row 50 - column of 1st character of string of 2 characters to be searched 20 - string of 2 characters to be searched OG.

(16) The first 5 OTSP String Search Competition ID publishing a right solution on page "http://www.syngear.co.uk/otsp-string-search-competition.php" will be the winners. Solutions published at the respective text field on page "http://www.syngear.co.uk/otspcompetition.php" marked as "edited" are invalid.

(17) On 21:05 hours the weekly OTSP String Search Competition will be closed.

(18) After some minutes the first 5 winners will be reported.

(19) The first winner will earn 50 \in , the second 30 \in , the third 10 \in and the other winners 5 \in each.

(20) The winner has to pay income tax.
